From within the Chrome Browser, Select the Account button to access your account settings.

### **Enable 2 Factor Verification**



Select the [Security tab] on the left side of the page, then scroll down to the [Signing in to Google] area. Make sure that 2-Step Verification is turned on. If not, you will need to turn it on.

This will be set for all gmail accounts starting May 30,2022 and can not be disabled

Then Select [Other (Custom name)] and input a name for your app – for example, I used RicohScanner

Then Select [Generate] to create a unique 16 digit password for your app

The 16 character password is automatically generated and provided to you. Copy this password as you will need it for your device.

Go to the settings for your Google Account in the application or device you are trying to set up. Replace your password with the 16character password shown above. Just like your normal password, this app password grants complete access to your Google Account. You won't need to remember it, so don't write it down or share it with anyone.
